Summary:

The National Aquarium Moving Image Collection consists of motion picture films and videos produced by the National Aquarium or for the National Aquarium in furthering its mission: to inspire the conservation of the world's aquatic treasures. These include documentation of: planning and construction of buildings and exhibits; events and programs; meetings and press conferences; local and national media coverage; public service announcements and television commercials; focus groups and marketing research; training and educational videos; staff and guest lectures; facilities and life support systems; and documentation of the animals in the collection through recording animal care, enrichment, behaviors, medical procedures, and rescue and rehabilitation. The bulk of the collection documents the National Aquarium's history in Baltimore, Maryland. The collection also includes documentation of the National Aquarium in Washington, D.C.
